They are accredited for both ISO Guide 34:2009 for Organic Reference Materials and to ISO/IEC 17025:2005 for Chemical Testing.

PJLA has now applied to the Asia Pacific Laboratory Accreditation Cooperation (APLAC) for the expansion of our current recognition program to include Reference Material Producer accreditation. This application has been accepted by the APLAC community and an on-site evaluation will be completed by the first/second quarter of 2013. Once this is completed, we will go under a review by the APLAC MRA Council and a decision will be made to grant PJLA full signatory status for the accreditation of reference material producers. During the course of this process PJLA will continue as appropriate in the accreditation industry, to accredit reference material producers.
